**Declaration of Legal Presence in the United States
for Students in Workforce & Economic Development
Programs at YORK TECHNICAL COLLEGE**

As of June 4, 2008, the South Carolina Illegal Immigration Reform Act (S.C. Code Ann: 59-101-430) prohibits those unlawfully present in the United States from attending a public institution of higher education in South Carolina and from receiving a public higher education benefit:

- An alien unlawfully present in the United States is not eligible to attend a public institution of higher learning in this State, as defined in Section 59-103-5. The trustees of a public institution of higher learning in this State shall develop and institute a process by which lawful presence in the United States is verified. In doing so, institution personnel shall not attempt to independently verify the immigration status of any alien, but shall verify any alien's immigration status with the federal government pursuant to 8 U.S.C. Section 1373(c).
- An alien unlawfully present in the United States is not eligible on the basis of residence for a public higher education benefit including, but not limited to, scholarship, financial aid, grants, or resident tuition.

YORK TECHNICAL COLLEGE may require you to submit documentation that supports your claim for lawful presence. Any student who is found to be unlawfully present in the United States will be dismissed from college.
